REMARKS: Possible oil is approximately 12 miles southeast of Louisiana Birds Foot and is nearby the Destroyed Taylor Platform, a suspected point source. Anomaly extends to the north-northwest of suspected point source for approximately 1.75 miles. Anomaly also has a weak feather and tail structure with heavier oil on the western edge of anomaly.
