Destroyed Taylor Platform: [28°56'9" N / 88°58'12" W]

Remarks:

A 1.5 mile wide anomaly extends 12 mile toward the northeast of known source point of Destroyed Taylor Platform. The contrast is not as distinct as prior anomalies seen at Taylor but still distinguishable to surroundings. The anomaly is on average about 12 miles to the Southeast of coastal islands of Bird's Foot.
