REMARKS:

Suspected oil is seen originating from the Destroyed Taylor platform in this Landsat-5 image. NCOM model data indicates the presence of a convergence zone off the southeast corner of the Birds' Foot Delta with west to west-southwest surface currents. For this reason, all of the suspected oil seen in this image is believed to be from the Destoryed Taylor.
