

REMARKS:

A possible oil slick from the destroyed Taylor platform extended for 9.0 miles to the NNE. The slick was quite narrow--up to 0.2 mile wide. Sky conditions were mostly clear near the platform, but were partly to mostly cloudy farther north, preventing full view of the most northern extent. Winds were light on the most part and coming out of the south.
