REMARKS:

Suspected oil sheen is observed emanating from the destroyed Taylor platform. The slick extends to the southwest for approximately 3km and is 1km in width. Wind data is not available in the immediate vicinity. Edges are not clearly defined due to low resolution but this feature can be differentiated from the nearby clouds and determined to be on the ocean surface by the lack of shadow.
