REMARKS:

Two separated elongated slick features seen off the eastern shores of the LA Bird's Foot delta. Southern slick appears to be connected to suspected point source (Destroyed Taylor Platform) and is about 19 miles long and 3/4-1.0 miles wide. The northern elongated slick is approximately 1-2 miles offshore and 3-4 miles northeast of Blind Bay, LA. It is 12 miles long and about 3/4-1.0 miles wide. Additionally there are three small more circular sheens seen to the northeast of the northern elongated slick.
